

Holiday Lighting National Averages

National Average Pricing for Christmas Lighting Services

Basic Christmas Lighting Services

- **Installation Cost:** \$240 to \$650 on average, or \$2.75 to \$5.00 per linear foot. This includes both the holiday lights and labor .
- Labor Costs: \$60 to \$100 per hour for individual installers; professional companies may charge \$75 to \$100 per hour.

Package Pricing

Standard Package

Average Cost: \$500 to \$1,000

Includes:

- Basic roofline lighting with high-quality LED lights.
- Light installation and removal.
- · Up to 150 linear feet of lighting.
- · Simple design with white or single-color lights.
- · No additional decorations or complex designs.

Deluxe Package

Average Cost: \$1,000 to \$2,000

Extreme Package

Average Cost: \$2,000 to \$4,000+

Includes:

- Extensive custom lighting for roofline, trees, shrubs, and landscape.
- · Light installation, removal, and storage.
- Up to 500 linear feet of lighting or more.
- Multiple colors and themes, including synchronized light shows.
- · Additional decorations such as large wreaths, garlands, and figurines.
- Professional design consultation to create a unique and personalized display.

Details:

- · Perfect for large homes or those wanting a standout, professional-grade display.
- Includes high-end, commercial-grade LED lights and advanced control systems.
- Full maintenance, including bulb replacement and emergency repairs during the season

Light Types and Costs

- Incandescent Lights: \$4 to \$20 per strand. These are the traditional, cheaper lights but consume more energy and burn out faster.
- **LED Lights:** \$6 to \$60 per strand. These are more energy-efficient, last longer, and are a popular choice for professional installations.
- Additional Light Types: Dome lights, C3, C5, C6, C7, C9, and commercial-grade lights range from \$5 to \$50 per strand depending on type and quality.

Additional Costs

- **Light Removal:** \$100 to \$300, or \$0.50 to \$0.60 per linear foot. This is often included in the installation package .
- Outdoor Electrical Outlets: \$200 to \$275 per outlet if new wiring is needed .
- Timers: \$10 to \$50 each for automatic light timers .

Pricing Based on Material Cost Plus Margin

To price Christmas lighting services based on material cost plus margin, use the following formula:

Total Job Cost = (Labor Hours x Hourly Labor Cost) + Overhead Cost per Job + Equipment Cost per Job + Taxes + Profit Margin

- Hourly Labor Cost: \$60 to \$100 per hour .
- **Profit Margin:** Typically ranges from 10% to 20% depending on business goals and market competition .

For example, if a lighting job takes 5 hours at \$80 per hour, with \$100 in overhead costs, \$200 in equipment costs, and a 15% profit margin, the calculation would be:

Total Job Cost =
$$(5 \times \$80) + \$100 + \$200 + (15\% \text{ of } \$700) = \$700 + \$105 = \$805$$

This approach ensures all costs are covered while providing room for profit, maintaining a sustainable business mode
