

# **National Average Pricing for Housekeeping Services**

## **Basic Housekeeping Services**

- Hourly Rate: \$25 to \$75 per hour, per cleaner .
- Per Room: \$30 to \$50 per room.
- Per Square Foot: \$0.10 to \$0.17 per square foot for standard cleaning, and \$0.15 to \$0.25 per square foot for deep cleaning .

#### Flat Rates Based on Home Size

- Studio Apartment:
  - Standard Cleaning: \$60 to \$90
  - **Deep Cleaning:** \$90 to \$110
  - Move-Out Cleaning: \$100 to \$120
- 1-Bedroom, 1-Bathroom:
  - Standard Cleaning: \$60 to \$90
  - **Deep Cleaning:** \$90 to \$110
  - Move-Out Cleaning: \$100 to \$120
- · 2-Bedroom, 1-Bathroom:
  - Standard Cleaning: \$90 to \$120
  - Deep Cleaning: \$120 to \$175
  - Move-Out Cleaning: \$120 to \$180
- · 3-Bedroom, 2-Bathroom:
  - Standard Cleaning: \$135 to \$180
  - **Deep Cleaning:** \$180 to \$280
  - Move-Out Cleaning: \$180 to \$300
- 4-Bedroom, 3-Bathroom:
  - Standard Cleaning: \$200 to \$225
  - **Deep Cleaning:** \$200 to \$400
  - Move-Out Cleaning: \$200 to \$390 .

## **Additional Services**

- Oven and Fridge Cleaning: Additional \$25 to \$50 per appliance.
- Window Cleaning: \$5 to \$10 per window.
- · Laundry Services: \$10 to \$20 per load.
- Pet Hair Removal: Additional \$20 to \$50 depending on the severity .

## **Pricing Based on Material Cost Plus Margin**

To price housekeeping services based on material cost plus margin, use the following formula:

Total Job Cost = (Labor Hours x Hourly Labor Cost) + Overhead Cost per Job + Equipment Cost per Job + Taxes + Profit Margin

- · Hourly Labor Cost: \$15 to \$25 per hour .
- **Profit Margin:** Typically ranges from 10% to 20% depending on business goals and market competition .

For example, if a cleaning job takes 3 hours with two cleaners at \$20 per hour, with \$30 in overhead costs, \$15 in equipment costs, and a 15% profit margin, the calculation would be:

Total Job Cost = 
$$(3 \times 2 \times \$20) + \$30 + \$15 + (15\% \text{ of } \$195) = \$195 + \$29.25 = \$224.25$$

This ensures all costs are covered while providing room for profit, maintaining a sustainable business model.
