

# **Pricing Guide for Pest Control Business**

# **Initial Inspection and Assessment**

Average Cost: \$75 to \$200

 Details: A comprehensive inspection of the property to identify pest issues and recommend appropriate treatments. Some companies offer free initial inspections as part of a package deal.

#### **General Pest Control Services**

Single Visit: \$100 to \$300

• Includes: Treatment for common pests like ants, spiders, and roaches.

• Frequency: Suitable for immediate issues; follow-up treatments may be necessary .

• Monthly Service: \$40 to \$70 per month

• Includes: Regular treatments to prevent pest infestations.

Frequency: Recommended for ongoing protection against common pests.

Quarterly Service: \$100 to \$300 per quarter

• **Includes:** Seasonal treatments to keep pests at bay throughout the year.

• Frequency: Good balance between cost and effectiveness for most homes .

## **Specialized Pest Control Services**

## Termite Treatment:

• **Inspection**: \$100 to \$300

• **Treatment:** \$500 to \$3,000 depending on the severity of the infestation and treatment method (e.g., chemical treatment, bait systems, fumigation).

• Annual Termite Protection Plan: \$200 to \$500 per year .

#### Bed Bug Treatment:

• Inspection: \$50 to \$200

• **Treatment:** \$300 to \$1,500 per room, depending on the extent of the infestation and treatment method (e.g., heat treatment, chemical treatment).

#### Rodent Control:
